

Teacher information for Evacuee Living History Week (18 - 21 June 2018)



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This event is being run in partnership with the Isle of Wight Steam Railway and the Heritage Education Service. The activities are designed to help students imagine what it might have been like to be evacuated to the Island during the early stages of the Second World War.

Location: Havenstreet Steam Railway

Each half day session will include:

- A 35-40 minute train journey from Havenstreet to Smallbrook and then returning to Havenstreet, with a simulated waving off and pretend bomb on the line!
- A rotation of the following three activities: wartime toys and games, a wartime lesson interrupted by an air raid and war time food tasting/rationing.
- All session leaders will be dressed in WWII style clothing.
- Access to all facilities at the Isle of Wight Steam Railway to use before/after your session.

Cost:

The cost of the trip will be £9.00 per student. One Adult per eight paying children go free (special needs assistants working 1:1 are automatically free).
