



HUNNYHILL PRIMARY SCHOOL, NEWPORT– NEW RESOURCED PROVISION

1. Notice is hereby given, in accordance with Section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006, that Isle of Wight Council intends to make a prescribed alteration to HUNNYHILL PRIMARY SCHOOL, Forest Rd, Newport PO30 5SH (category of school – community) by increasing the capacity of the school, with effect from 1 September 2020.
2. The objectives of the proposal are to provide a new resourced provision based at Hunnyhill Primary School to accommodate pupils in the primary age range (4–11) with social, emotional and mental health (SEMH) difficulties on the Isle of Wight.
3. The current capacity of Hunnyhill Primary School is 420 and it is proposed to create capacity at a new resourced provision at the school by offering 8 new places. This will not affect the overall capacity of mainstream places at Hunnyhill Primary School.
4. There is no capital cost for this project.
