

**Transfer Review Timetable – Updated 26 August 2015**

**Statements of SEN and LDAs (S139a/Moving on Plans) into Education, Health & Care Plans**

The Department for Education has stated that there will be a three and half year timescale to transfer those with a Statement of SEN (by 31 March 2018), and a two and half year timescale to transfer those with an LDA (by 1 September 2016) if the young person is continuing in further education or training beyond 1 September 2016

Schools and professionals will need to be aware that up-to-date information will have to be gathered as part of the transfers review process, including ‘Our Story’ and ‘My Story/One Page Profile’. There will need to be a discussion regarding pupil focused outcomes for the next year and the next phase.

For post 16, it is anticipated there will be very few conversions, only for those who specifically request an Education, Health & Care Plan and those still in education in Year 14 from September 2016, if continued education beyond this point is considered appropriate.
