## **Petition – To save our Totland Sea Wall**

A petition of over 2,500 island residents has been received. In line with the Council's Constitution, details of the submitted petition must be published on our website.

The petition asks for the IW Council to reinstate the sea wall by whatever means possible, and is due to be considered at the Council meeting on 26 February 2014. This meeting commences at 5pm and is held in the Council Chamber, County Hall, Newport, Isle of Wight.

At the meeting, the petition organiser will have a total of 5 minutes to address the Council on the issues. The local Member, Cllr Howe, will then be able to make his comments (for a maximum of 3 minutes), Council will then have a maximum of 15 minutes in which to debate the matter and make a decision.
