Gardens/Greens/Seating areas

- 1 Silver Jubilee Garden, junction of Church Road and High Street
- 2 Cliff top green off Fisherman's Walk, adjacent to the Lifeboat Station car park
- 3 Cliff top green at end of Beachfield Road, adjacent to Coastguard Station
- 4 Junction of of Sherbourne Street, Kings Road and Church Road
- 5 Corner of High Street/Church Road
- 6 Land at Scout Hut and Bowling Green, Mitten Road
- 7 Land Station Road to the rear of Harbour Strand
- 8 Downsview Road (private open space)
- 9 Cliff top land adjacent to Sandhills Holiday Park
- 10 Chestnut tree adjacent Bembridge Windmill
- 11 Adjacent bend at upper end of Howgate Road
