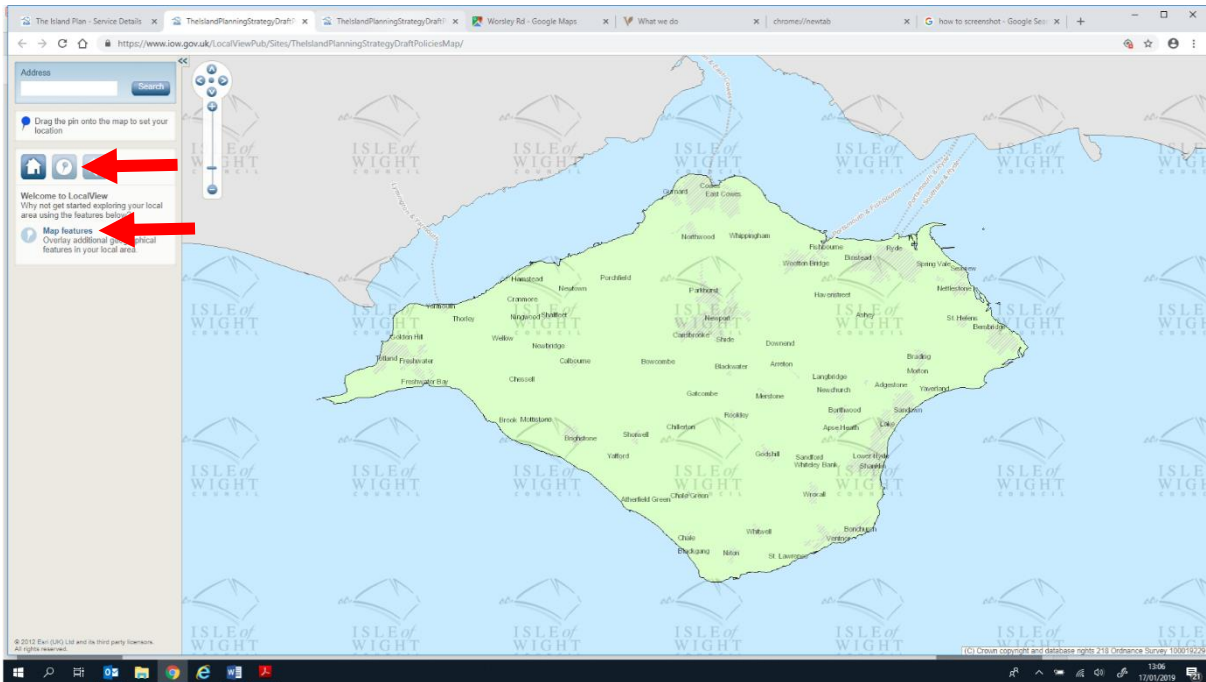


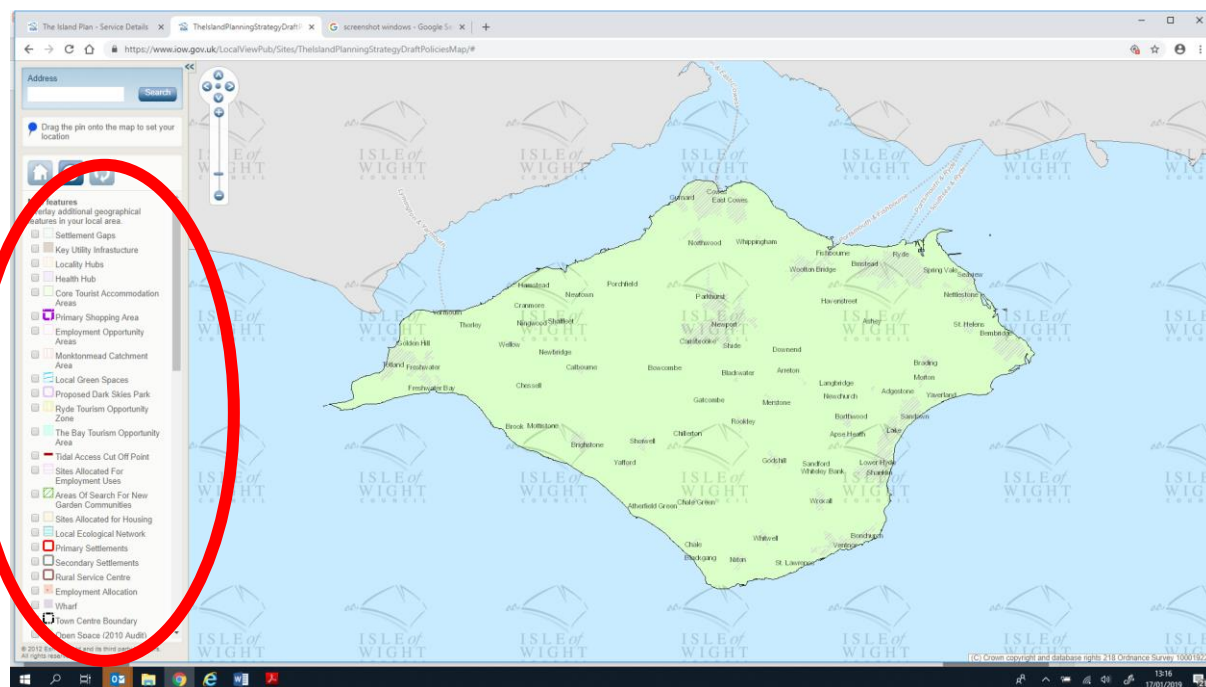
A quick guide to using the draft Policies Map

The draft Policies Map shows the policies of the draft Island Planning Strategy 'on the ground'. For example, it will show the extent of a proposed local green space designation or employment allocation.

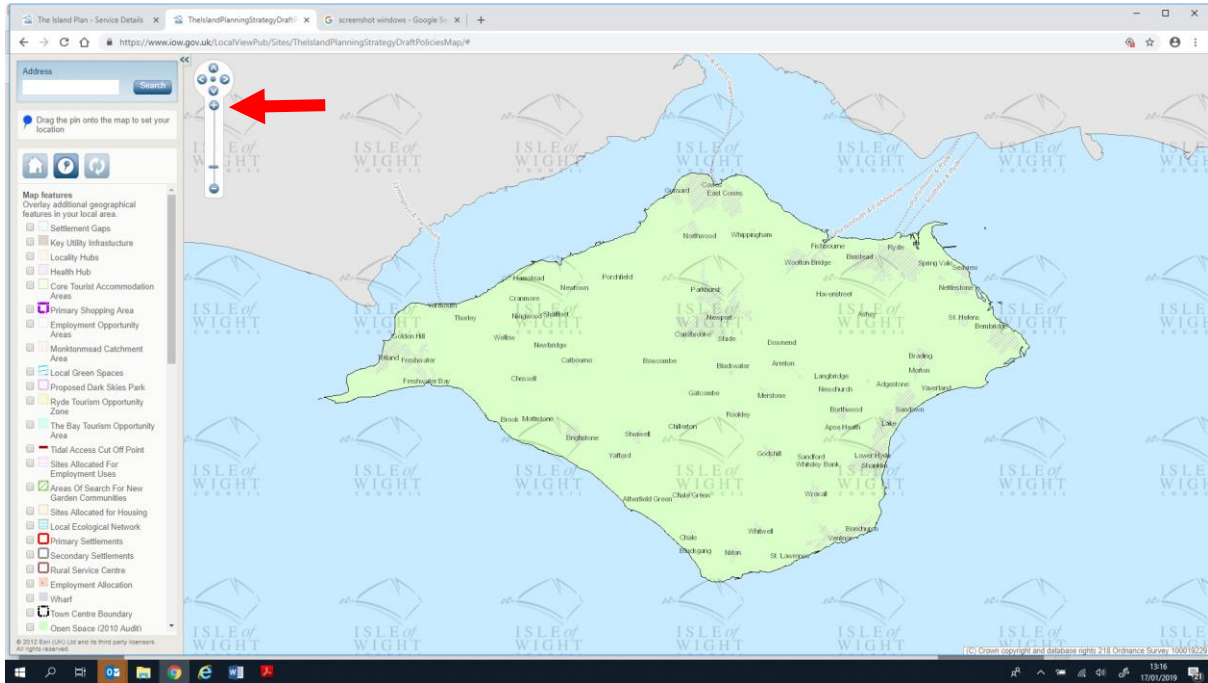
On the Policies Map homepage, click on the Map features text or the pin icon on the left-hand side, as shown below:



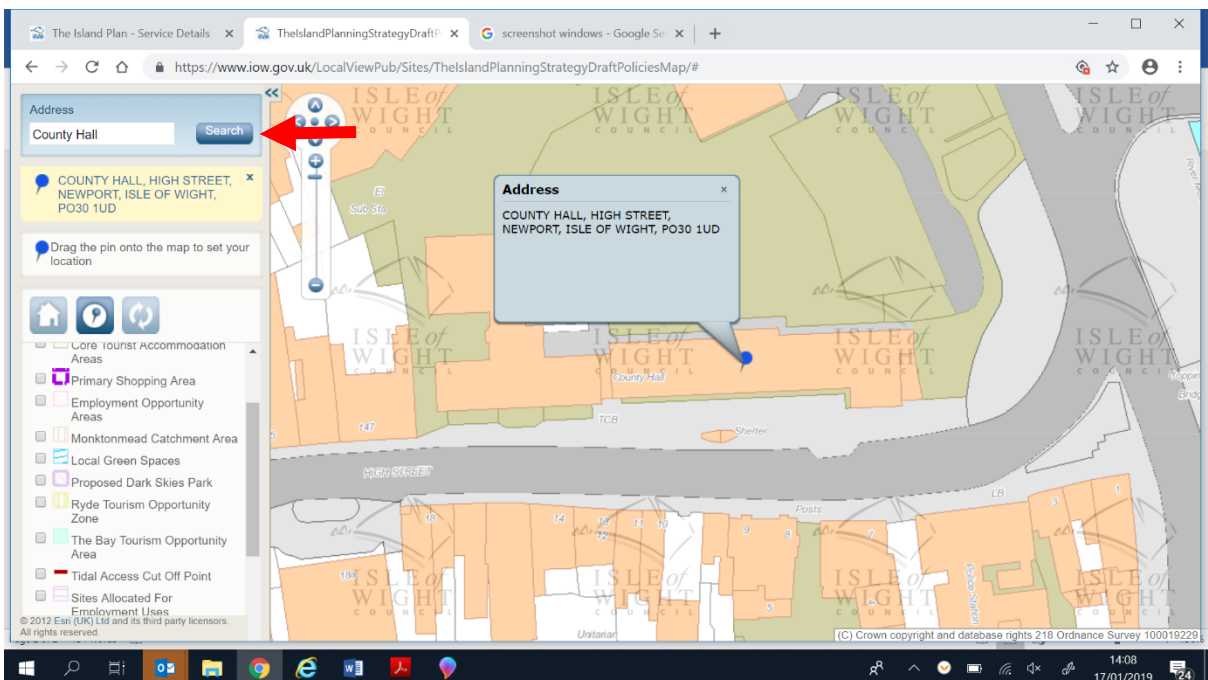
You will then be able to select any of the policies and layers you wish to view by clicking the relevant box on the menu. The scroll bar will let you view all of the policies and layers you select. When a layer is selected a tick will appear in the box.



You can then 'zoom in' on the map to your required location, either using the wheel on your mouse or the plus icon in zoom function in the top left-hand corner. You can also navigate across the map by holding down the left mouse button and moving to your required location.



Alternatively, you can insert the address you want to look at in the Address box and then click Search. This will either take you to the location (as shown below), or a range of addresses will appear below the Address box.



The selected layers and location can be reset by clicking on the 'refresh' icon.
