

St Mary's Junction

Major works to remodel the junction at St Mary's roundabout start next Monday (30 September).

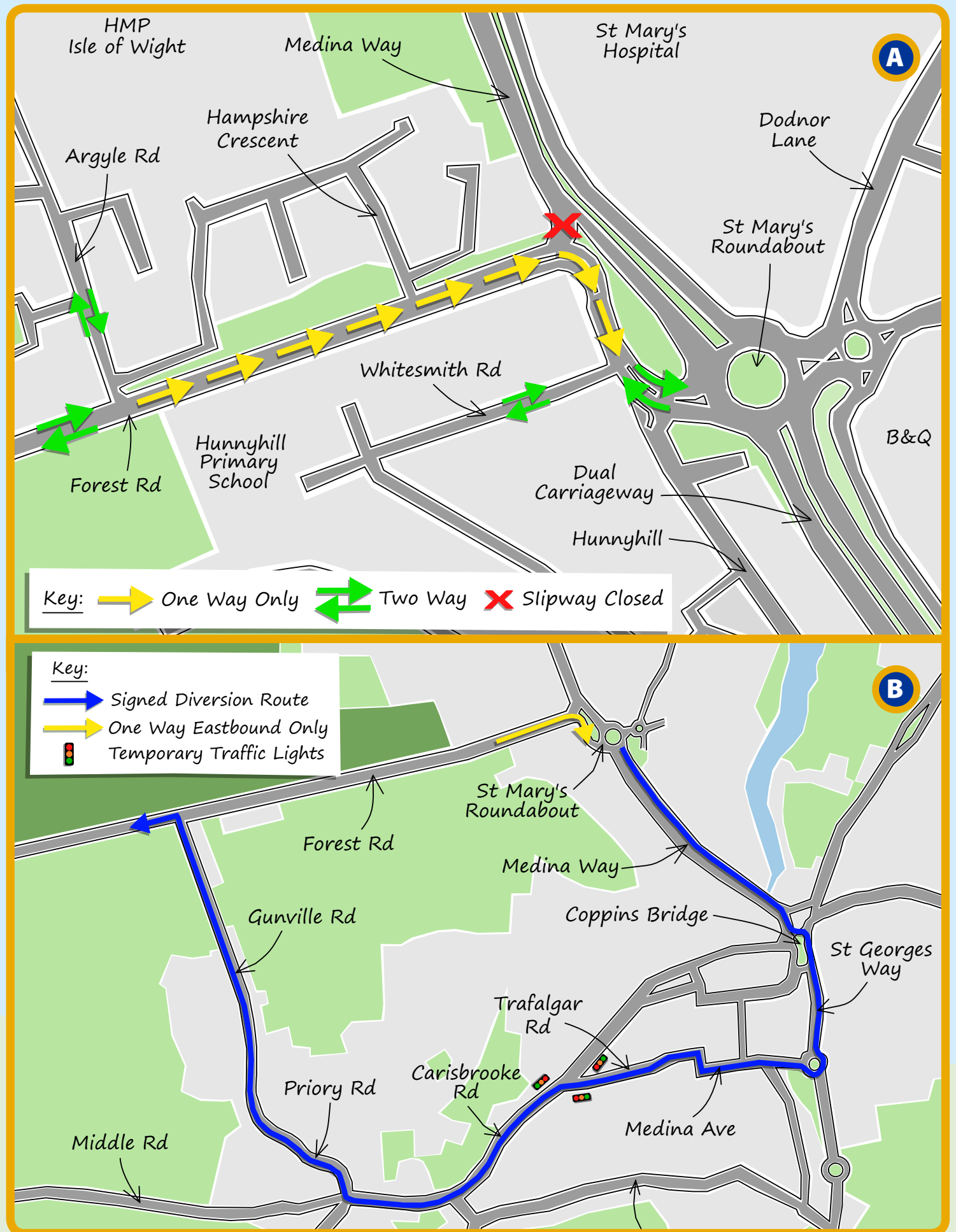
The scheme is part of a wider package of improvements which, once complete, will make journeys for those travelling in and around Newport much easier with fewer delays.

The 15-month scheme will replace the existing roundabout with two, linked traffic light-controlled junctions.

The work is intended to 'future-proof' this busy junction given the expected growth in traffic movement in the area and unlock former prison land at Camp Hill for redevelopment.

These maps show the first four phases of the work up until Christmas, detailing road and lane closures to help people plan their journeys.

Work will pause over the Christmas and New Year period when the roundabout will operate as usual. Further updates will be provided in December.

Improvement Works

Phase 1 and 2

30 September to 3 November (inclusive)

- A** Forest Road one-way.
- A** Cowes slip road closed. Those wishing to travel to Cowes from Forest Road will need to continue to St Mary's roundabout and turn left.
- B** Phase 1 and 2 diversion route for traffic travelling from Newport to the West Wight.

B&Q works

Mid October for two weeks

Overnight works to provide an additional lane, between 8pm and 4am only.

Phase 3 and 4

4 November to 20 December (inclusive)

- Forest Road two-way.
- Outside lane on approach to St Mary's roundabout from Cowes closed.
- Outside lane of dual carriageway northbound (towards Cowes) closed.
- Inside lane of St Mary's roundabout closed.
- Right-hand lane from B&Q roundabout to St Mary's roundabout closed.
