The data collected in this form will be sent to the following: Amey Integrated Services and will be shared with relevant council departments for the administration of the scheme only.

We will keep your personal data for the length of your green garden waste subscription and will be deleted upon expiry or contract cancellation once green garden waste receptacles have been returned to the Isle of Wight Council.

You have a number of rights under the data protection legislation. Please note not all of these rights apply to all processing and any request will be considered on a case by case basis. Your rights include:
