

How to purchase a parking permit in MiPermit

Apply for a permit here

If you have previously set up an account with MiPermit, enter your details.

If you have not previously set up an account, you will be given the opportunity to do so during the application process.

To purchase a new permit, either choose the tab 'Buy Digital Permits', or scroll down the page and select the required option

Car Park Permits

This should be used to purchase an All Island Car Park Permit

Resident Car Park Permits

To be used by a resident who resides within a 200m radius of a car park to purchase a permit for that car park

Resident On-Street Permits

To be used to enable a resident to purchase pay and display on-street permit

Residents Zone Permits

To be used to enable a resident to purchase a permit for parking within a resident zone

Visitor Permits

To be used to enable a resident of a zone to purchase a permit for a visitor to their home
