- 6. Your entry e-mail must include your design as well as your name, age, contact details (email and telephone number). You may also include some information about the idea behind your design.
- 7. Submit your entry by emailing it to roadsafety@iow.gov.uk.
- 8. You must sign and submit a copy of these terms and conditions along with your entry. If you are under 18 years old, your parent/guardian must also sign these terms and conditions, and they must submit the entry on your behalf.
