

Registrar fees 2022 - 2023

Fees are reviewed annually. Statutory fees are subject to a review each April. The fees detailed below are applicable from 1 April 2022 - 31 March 2023.

New fees will be payable for any ceremonies held after the review date. Please contact us if you would like to check any of the fees.

Fees for ceremonies are payable three weeks before the date of your ceremony. If booked within six weeks of the ceremony date, fees are due immediately. We accept payment by cash or card only.

Service	Fee	Additional information
Booking	£45.00	This non-refundable fee secures the date and time of your ceremony. You can book up to two years in advance. The fee allows for one change of date, time or venue. This fee is not a deposit and is not deducted from your overall ceremony fee.
Notice	£35.00 each	Each person giving notice of marriage or civil partnership pays a statutory fee. This fee may be higher if you are subject to immigration control.
